Will you help her?”*



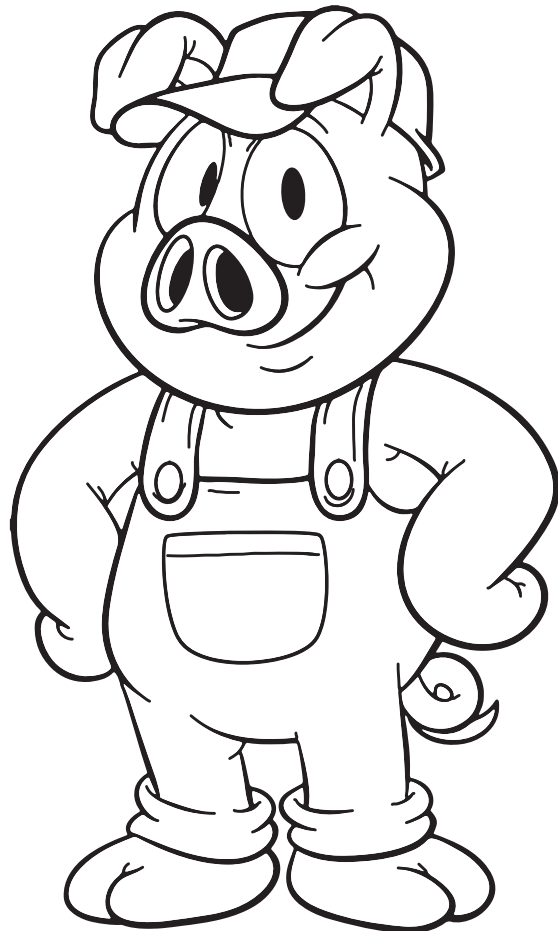
